Footnotes

PRIZED HUMOUR showed speed then forced the pace, took the lead nearing the turn and moved clear then held sway under a drive in the stretch. CALL FOR SILVER pressed the pace from late backstretch, stalked on the turn then rallied determinedly. SANGORE pressed the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn and finished gamely. DARK CLOUD DANCER, rated off the pace, was blocked at the top of the stretch, was roused a furlong out and tendered a mild rally. DO THE MATH stalked the pace from between horses, chased into the stretch but had no late response. CANDY BULL had a short early lead, was headed nearing the turn, chased, but evened out midstretch. MAVERICK MAN, rated off the pace, was hustled three-wide into the stretch but lacked a late response. RIMAL AL SAHARA, off alertly, stalked the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn then flattened out in the late stages.
