MAN STUFF dueled late backstretch, gained a short lead on the turn, drew off in the stretch and finished under a hand ride. ONE NINE NINE raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the turn then finished willingly. BADON, off alertly, settled midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn then rallied belatedly. CITY TRIP settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the turn, was game to deep stretch then evened out. WHEN FLASHING raced off the pace, chased hard late turn, was all out through the stretch but evened out late. HENNY'S HEART, in range, chased on the turn then flattened out midstretch. SAMANTHA ROYALE raced in midpack, was hustled along between foes then lacked a rally. KITTIIHAWA raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a closing response. STORMY BEAUTY held a short early lead, was joined in a duel then was headed and forced the pace on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired in the final furlong. WON OPPORTUNITY stalked the pace, dropped back a bit along the rail on the turn and tired in the stretch.
