### Footnotes

MOUNTAIN ECHO raced off the pace, was hustled six-wide late turn, rallied outside and swept by the leader midstretch, driving. ZINN HOUSE DOLL forced the pace, backed away from a tight spot at the turn, was hustled along then finished gamely. KAIN'S VOW raced off the pace, was hustled into the stretch and finished determinedly. BLING BLING QUEEN sprinted to the lead, set the pace, was passed midstretch and tired. OFFICER'S DREAM stalked the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. JOVIAL JILL forced the pace, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. TETHRA'S WORD stumbled at the start, raced in touch with the leader from between rivals, chased late turn then flattened out. EXECUTIVE SHERRI settled well back early, saved ground but was never in contention. MRS. MATHIAS stalked the pace, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch.
