DREAM'N DESIRE vied outside foes while 3-wide, forced the pace and then took charge on the turn, opened up on the rest and was much the best. ONE SWEET RIDE came from off the early pace to close from the inside on the turn, finished willingly and was a clear second best. ENGLISH MATTERS gained ground from the rail after trailing early and put in a mild try. MORNING PRAYERS vied from inside of foes and led briefly into the turn then was no match for the winner and faded from the scene. LA GRAN RUBY off the pace, failed to menace and came up empty. PERFECT HEART was well back throughout and lacked a rally. TOPSY TAPPER lost ground from mid pack and did not fire. FIGURE EIGHT forced the pace and was a factor into the turn then faded. CRAZY EYES stalked the pace duel and kept contact then faltered.
