Footnotes

BOLIVAR raced off the pace, closed on the turn, rallied gamely and got up late, driving. ANY GIVEN ROYAL raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn, rallied between rivals and missed. BEAR SKY, off the early pace, closed into the turn, bid midturn, dueled, gained a narrow lead midstretch then failed to hold the top two safe. THAMES TRADER led early, was headed, rebid midturn, dueled, the gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. FATHOM'S END, in range, backed away a bit at the turn, chased to the stretch and rallied outside. COLT DU JOUR sprinted to an early lead, set the pace, was joined midturn, dueled but yielded a furlong out. VENTURE EXCHANGE, well back early, chased on the turn but never reached contention. CAPE RACE settled off the pace, closed into the turn, bid midturn, dueled then tired at the top of the stretch. ONE FOR JACK raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the late stages. HAS IT NOW bobbled slightly at the start and was eased late on the backstretch.
