### Footnotes

SIR HEART THROB, well back early, closed along the inside on the turn, moved the rail upper stretch, responded to encouragement and swept by the leader in the late stages. PAPERS TO PROVE IT showed speed, moved clear approaching the turn, set a reserved pace then failed to contain the winner in deep stretch. TOMBALL settled in range, was hustled on the turn, was all out in the stretch then evened out late. KWIK COSTA broke very sharply but dropped back quickly, raced off the pace angling from three-wide to five-wide on the turn, passed tiring horses and did not threaten. BERNARD TERRACE raced well off the pace, trailed on the turn and never reached contention. MOLINARO TEMPO raced off the pace, chased hard three and four-wide on the turn and did not menace. SUFFONCIFIED forced the pace early backstretch, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch.
