WILDCAT MARIE broke outward then pulled to a narrow lead, set a pressured pace to the turn and drew clear then held sway under steady handling through the stretch. ARIANA D was close early but settled and dropped to the rear of the field, closed four and five-wide on the turn then launched a determined drive and finished best of the rest. INDIAN APPLE IS settled in range, fell back late turn while under a ride, came five-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied late outside. SHUKRIYA pressed the pace on the backstretch, chased three-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out in the late stages. HOOH WHY raced in the middle of the pack from the outside, chased four-wide late turn but evened out with a 16th to run. WACCAMAW, squeezed back at the start, moved up inside the pacesetter late backstretch but eased back entering the turn, remained in striking range to the stretch but had no response when asked.
