RUNNING SINGLE dueled from between horses, edged clear past midturn then widened through the stretch under left handed encouragement. HIGHLAND FLARE raced midpack from the rail then two-wide, was hustled into the stretch and finished gamely in vain. SELECTIVE SHOPPER was taken back early,

closed between foes on the turn, posted a steady gain but did not menace. ELIZABETH'S TUNE was hustled to the early lead, was headed and pressed the pace on the turn then evened out in the stretch. OHSOGENTLE raced midpack, moved to the rail midturn, rallied between horses but evened out late. THREE THIRTEEN raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide through the turn then lacked a stretch response. LEGENDARY ELLA raced midpack, angled from the fourth-path to six-wide on the turn but never threatened. ESSA'S HONOR raced off the pace, saved ground then lacked a closing response. HOLLYGRAEME raced midpack moving from the third path to five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. WIN BY A ROSE, in range, chased to the stretch and tired. BLACK NAPKINS was sent to the fore on the backstretch, dueled from the rail, was headed midturn, chased to the stretch and tired. ANGEL IN THE SNOW raced off the pace, came four then five-wide through the turn but lacked a rally.
