GOOD GENERAL held a short lead on the backstretch, was hustled clear into the turn then finished all out to hold sway. GARZON stalked the pace in hand, was hustled late turn then tendered a mild three-wide rally and was just up for second. DRUMBLARE broke awkwardly, stalked the pace on the backstretch and turn, chased along the rail into the stretch and finished determinedly despite the rider not carrying a whip. WHISKEYONTEROCKS forced the pace on the backstretch, chased two then three-wide on the turn and finished gamely to be best of the rest. MANNY WHO raced midpack, angled from the second to the fifth path on the turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. KILMOGANNY raced off the pace, came four-wide to seven-wide through the turn and was never a threat. DA POSSE, in range early, was hustled along angling from three-wide to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. MAPLE TINTS raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch then lacked a rally.
