Footnotes

GO JUICE, in range, angled from the rail to five-wide through the turn, launched an all out rally and was up in time under a drive. HIGHLAND FLARE raced midpack between foes, came four-wide into the stretch, rallied gamely but missed. MOONLIGHT MILE forced the pace from the rail, angled three-wide late turn, responded gamely and took command near midstretch but failed to hold in the late stages. BROOKE'S LEGACY, off slowly, raced well off the pace, angled from two-wide to six-wide on the turn then rallied gamely between rivals. SPECTACLE stalked the pace three and four-wide, was roused midturn, chased into the stretch but hung in the late stages. STORMY SHAY raced midpack, saved ground, was hustled into the stretch but evened out late. COWBOY'S DREAM held a short early lead, shook clear on the turn was collared in the final furlong and tired. LUV A MARINE stalked the pace, angled from four to seven-wide on the turn, was game in the stretch but needed a stronger response. MAYBE I CAN raced midpack, came three-wide to six-wide through the turn then lacked a stretch response. LET'S GET TRASHY raced in the middle of the pack, came five-wide into the stretch then lacked a rally.

SHESTWEAKIN was never in contention. MISS AQUARIUS raced off the pace, was roused late turn but showed no stretch response.
