RINGBANG CITY sprinted clear quickly, set a reserved pace, drew away at the top of the stretch and finished under light handling. AFLEET'S LOVE SONG, up close early, stalked from the rail on the turn then was all out through the stretch. HIP HIP HOORAY, up close three-wide, was hustled four-wide into the stretch, finished all out but was unable to gain. SOMETIME ANYTIME pressed the pace on the backstretch and turn then flattened out in the stretch. BROOKING raced midpack in hand, was roused at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. DANZATHRUTHEKNIGHT, unhurried early, angled from the third path to five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. SHELF, unhurried early, was hustled along the rail late turn but lacked a stretch response.
