Footnotes

HAILSTONE stalked the pace, was hustled late turn, surged to the lead just into the final furlong and was taken in hand nearing the wire. TRELAWNY showed speed, gained a short lead into the turn, moved clear, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled, then was passed in the final furlong. BEARS PITCH, away badly, closed along the rail on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, vied briefly and yielded. IF AND ALMOST, in range early, settled, chased four-wide late turn then rallied belatedly. HEYWOODS had speed and forced the pace on the backstretch, chased on the turn and into the stretch then evened out. DREAM HOLIDAY, in range, was steadied in traffic nearing the turn, chased from well back and did not threaten. BEAR'S A WINNAH, in touch between foes, angled from three to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then lacked a rally. ROYAL RAGE, up close, came four and five-wide through the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. STORMONTHEMOVE broke outward, quickly gained contention, dropped back nearing the turn and failed to menace.
