ESSENCE HIT MAN took command early on the backstretch, set a reserved pace then held under a light drive. D'S WANDO raced off the pace, closed along the rail through the turn, was set down in earnest at the top of the stretch, finished all out and was gaining at the end. BEAR'S HARD TEN raced off the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch and rallied determinedly. GARY D, in range early, was hustled three-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. FEARLESS COWBOY forced the pace on the backstretch, chased two-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. CITY TROOPER broke in the air, raced well off the pace, was lugging through the turn and stretch and lacked a rally. WILDCAT FRANKIE showed brief speed, was headed early backstretch, stalked the pace then backed away a bit on the turn then tired in the stretch.
