THE LADY IS SILVER stalked the early pace between horses, came outside the leader in the turn and closed the gap, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under strong urging. GRASSA DONNA was hustled along outside of rivals, roused three wide in the turn and got up for place. HEALING KNOWLEDGE stalked the early pace along the rail, dropped back in the turn but finished with a mild rally in the stretch. PROMISING WEST was unhurried early just off the rail, roused four wide in the turn and finished with a mild bid. DESTROY broke sharply and set the early pace but gave way in upper stretch and faded. RICH TOWNY stalked the early pace between horses but lacked a late response and was never a threat. KEPI was void of early speed between horses then dropped back in the turn. GORILLA MY DREAMS was hustled along on the rail then tired in the stretch and dropped back. BONITA BAY showed little and was outrun.
