BEARCATT, always in range, remained patient while at the rear of the pack on the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, responded smartly and swept to the lead midstretch. CONGOR BAY, rated off the pace, was hustled four-wide into the stretch, rallied gamely, needed more but just got up for the place. HEART OF A KING raced prominently between rivals, challenged the pacesetter at the top of the stretch, quickly drove to the lead then despite being all out was unable to stave off the winner a sixteenth out and grudgingly gave up the place. VALIANCY stalked the pace three-wide, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. CASEY'S ON CALL in range, was hustled along the rail on the turn then tired in the final furlong. BEAR IT'S TRUE showed speed on the backstretch, shook clear entering the turn, was engaged at the top of the stretch and tired.
