HARLEM PRINCESS pressed the pace, took command midturn, kept ahead of close contenders upper stretch and held sway and a light drive. CORAL SANDS raced in midpack, was hustled late turn then rallied gamely along the rail. EMCEE RUSH stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn but evened out in deep stretch. OUR TRUE GAL raced off the pace, was hustled between foes on the turn then evened out in the stretch. ALTA LAKE raced off the pace, chased four-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. GRACE BY MOONLIGHT settled well back early, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. SILVER MINIKIN raced off the pace, chased on the turn angling from the rail to four-wide then evened out in the stretch. FUTURE CUPID led early, set a pressured pace, was passed midturn, chased briefly and tired.
