Footnotes

BRISTOL BABE was allowed to settle well off the rail, roused 4 wide around the turn and was full of run in the stretch, assumed command and drew clear under a drive. LITTLE OPRAH was in hand, made a quick move along the rail and assumed command at the 1/2 pole, could not hold off the winner and gave way in the late going. KAYLA'S WISH was void of early speed, closed the gap along the rail at the 3/8 pole, but weakened in the drive. ORCHESTRA was in hand stalking the early pace between horses and lacked a late response. LAVERLOCHERE was unhurried early on the inside, never rallied and was never a threat. FOREIGN CURRENCY was hustled along between horses in the backstretch, then weakened around the turn. KASSIE'S GEM was away alertly and set the early pace 3 wide, faltered at the 3/8 pole and dropped back.
