A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$3,000, which includes the entry fee.(1 supplement) Plus up to \$18,450 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Nominations closed Wednesday, April 11, 2007 with 16.

JUST RUSHING took a short early lead, was joined in a duel on the backstretch, vied outside ARE YOU SERIOUS then dug in late and prevailed under a drive. ARE YOU SERIOUS settled quickly then moved up the rail to the fore, vied gamely with JUST RUSHING but was outfinished in the late stages. JUDITHS WILD RUSH stalked three-wide, chased late turn and was all out through the stretch but hung late. SHILLELAGH SLEW, in touch, saved ground, was hustled late turn and was all out in the stretch but hung. BEAR CHARACTER, close early in hand, was jostled a bit entering the turn and dropped back three-wide then evened out in the stretch. GOOD AND LUCKY, prominent between foes, was jostled entering the turn, dropped back and lacked a rally.
