Footnotes

JULIANSHOME raced in midpack, closed four-wide on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch, bid a furlong out, dueled, then edged ahead late under a drive. VIGILARE raced off the pace, chased on the turn, drove to the rail approaching the top of the stretch, bid quickly and gained command briefly, was joined a furlong out, dueled but was outfinished. BENEVOLENT KNIGHT raced off the pace, closed three-wide between rivals late turn, finished gamely, but late. GOLD BOOK settled off the pace, saved ground, angled out upper stretch then rallied mildly outside the field. AFTER DINNER had speed, set a pressured pace, shook clear on the turn, was caught upper stretch and gave way. AFTERNOON IDOL broke inwards and bumped ZIZI, forced the pace, chased late turn but flattened out midstretch. CLAYMIESTER stalked the pace, closed four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. ZIZI, bumped at the start, forced the pace, chased two-wide on the turn but had no response in the stretch.
