EXECUTIVE FIVE raced in midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn, rallied gamely and was up[just in time, driving. PASO DOBLE stalked the pace, chased from the top of the stretch and just missed. RAINCOATS'NTUXEDOS was sent to the early lead, dueled on the turn, shook clear upper stretch then failed to hold at the wire. HAVERHILL, off slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled two-wide on the turn then rallied between foes. ROYAL EGBERT forced the issue, bid into the turn, dueled, yielded upper stretch and tired. BEAR'S PEAK, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, chased along the rail late turn but flattened out midstretch. JENNA'S WABBIT stalked the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. OLD BLUE EYES settled off the pace, was bothered at the turn, drifted wide then lacked a rally. CREEPING BARRAGE broke badly, settled off the pace, lugged out at the turn and lost his rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE RUN INTO THE TURN LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
