Footnotes

ESSENCE OF SILVER raced midpack, angled three to five-wide on the turn, rallied willingly and got up late, driving. ELECTRIC ELISE stalked the pace, bid five-wide at the top of the stretch, drove clear then failed to hold in deep stretch. ADREAMANDAPRAYER forced the issue, took command into the turn, set a pressured pace, was headed upper stretch and chased to the wire. DANCIGER raced midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then finished evenly. TICKET TIME set a pressured pace, was headed nearing the turn, chased to the stretch and tired in the final furlong. LOLA B. raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. HIGHLAND FLARE, off a step slowly, saved ground, was roused late turn but had no response, finishing along the rail.
