**Footnotes**

STARSHIP SABRINA settled off the pace, closed two-wide on the turn, moved to the rail at the top of the stretch, swept to the lead inside the pacesetter upper stretch and widened under light handling. TWENTY BLACK settled in midpack, was hustled three-wide into the stretch, moved to the rail a furlong out and chased to the end. HYMN NOTE raced in midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, rallied outside and got up for 3rd. SOUTH BEACH ANNA raced in midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. STRAWBERRY SCARLET stumbled at the start, stalked the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. VALOREM stumbled at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground, angled out late turn and finished all out. SUBTLE SIGNAL dueled, shook clear on the turn, was passed upper stretch and tired. PETITE DIVA raced off the pace, chased late turn but never reached contention. SPEND TO SAVE forced the pace, chased on the turn then tired upper stretch. SAMANTHA ROYALE dueled, chased hard on the turn then tired upper stretch.
