TAMARIND HALL forced the pace three-wide, bid four-wide late turn, shook clear upper stretch then tired with a sixteenth to run. MINGUN MISS raced off the pace. was hustled between foes late turn then finished gamely in vain. IN THE MONEY showed early speed in hand, dueled on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. CENTRIPETAL MOTION, in touch early, bid along the rail into the turn, dueled but was headed upper stretch and tired. MARIA'S STORY raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled along the second path into the stretch then flattened out. STUNNING IN RED stalked the pace from the outside, came four-wide into the turn then was eased late turn.
