Footnotes

IMPOSSIBLE TIME, in touch while four-wide on the turn, was hustled into the stretch and swept to the lead just inside the furlong marker and finished under a hand ride. BLUE BLOOD WILDCAT broke alertly, forced the pace, bid early turn, vied, wore down her rival upper stretch then was no match for the winner. TETHRA'S WORD held a short lead, was pressured early then vied on the turn and tired upper stretch. MOONLIGHT DESIRE, in range between horses, was hustled into the stretch then evened out. MADAME TOUMANOVA forced the pace from the rail, bid upper stretch but failed to sustain the drive. LUNAR LINDA, in touch, was checked behind rivals entering the turn, angled from the rail to five-wide then evened out late. SPANISH DEPUTY, in touch two-deep, remained patient to the stretch but evened out in the late stages. INTERREGNUM raced off the pace, angled from three-wide to six-wide through the turn then needed more response in the stretch. LADY OF MYSTERY, in range, raced midpack on the turn, steadied slightly midstretch behind rivals then evened out. PRIMA DANNA, in range, angled out late turn, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out in the final sixteenth. JOHNNY'S CON raced off the pace, was hustled while angling out five-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. VENGANZA, well back early, was hustled from the third path to seven-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. WICKED EMER settled early, trailed the field and lacked a rally.
