Footnotes

PASO DOBLE, in range, closed late turn, was set down six-wide at the top of the stretch, swept to the lead in the final furlong and held sway under a drive. RACE FOR GOLD raced off the pace, closed angling from the rail to four-wide on the turn then finished determinedly. CAPTAIN CARLOS raced midpack, was roused six-wide late turn and finished all out between foes. BECKY'S KITTEN raced midpack, was hustled seven-wide late turn then finished gamely outside rivals. D'S WANDO raced midpack, was hustled on the turn, chased into the stretch, encountered a little traffic but finished gamely. AUTEUR, off a step slowly, raced well back, saved ground then finished gamely late between foes. DANIEL BE GOOD dueled on the backstretch, edged ahead entering the turn, set a pressured pace and held the lead to the final furlong, was passed, chased briefly and tired. BOGUE CHITTO stalked the early pace, forced the issue into the turn, chased to the stretch but tired a 16th out. GARY D broke outward and bumped DUBLIN LANE, chased up close, came four and five-wide through the turn then tired in the stretch. DUBLIN LANE, bumped at the start, stalked the pace, chased five and six-wide through the turn then tired midstretch. BEAR'S PROSPECTOR raced off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn, lugged out late turn, was straightened away for the stretch run but never reached contention. THE BOY'S RING dueled, dropped back a bit at the turn, chased to the final furlong and tired.
