SWEETSOUTHERN DOLL raced midpack, chased hard on the turn, was under an all out drive in the stretch and got by the leader in the late stages. CRAWFORD COUNTY, in touch, bid late turn, dueled, gained command a furlong out but was caught in deep stretch. SENSATIONAL LOVE raced off the pace, chased six-wide into the stretch, responded when asked and rallied gamely. KISSHER TO KEEPER stalked the pace, bid between rivals late turn, vied but gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. LUCKY N' BOLD set the pace, was pressured then joined late turn, dueled into the stretch but gave way grudgingly approaching the furlong marker. SARAROYAL, checked early behind rivals, trailed on the backstretch, closed angling from the rail to three-wide on the turn, launched an all out stretch drive but flattened out in the late stages. DEVIL'S BLAST raced off the pace, was steadied early turn then was hustled into the stretch but was not a threat. PLAUTIA URGULANILA, in touch, dropped back early turn and had no stretch response. TIME SHARING forced the pace, chased on the turn then tired upper stretch.
