### Footnotes

TREE RINGS raced midpack, angled from the second to fourth path late turn, angled out further upper stretch, rallied, and just got up under a drive. HUBBERT'S PEAK stalked the pace from the inside, was blocked from midturn, got through three-deep at the top of the stretch, gained command but failed to contain the winner at the wire. LUVYOUTOTHEMOON had speed, was quickly joined in a duel, drove clear at the top of the stretch, was headed upper stretch but still finished gamely. BOLD FINALE, in range, closed five-wide early turn, was hustled along then evened out in the stretch. SAND COVE closed three-deep into the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. CELERITY'S SUMMIT raced midpack along the rail, tired in the stretch. BORN LOOSE raced off the pace along the rail, angled three-wide late turn but failed to menace. VEGAS ANGEL closed four-deep into the turn, was hustled along then tired in the stretch. FRISKY WHISKEY gained a short lead late backstretch, vied on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. TRADING ON LINE, well back nearing the turn, moved from the second path to the fifth path through the turn then tired.
