SIERRA CAT, in touch between foes, was hustled out of the turn, angled out upper stretch and responded smartly and got up late under a drive. STOLONBOY pressed the pace in a race in which no one wanted the early lead, bid midway of the backstretch, vied to the turn then chased hard to the stretch, bid a sixteenth out and led briefly then failed to contain the winner late. FORTY CREEK, unhurried early, raced three-wide, swung five-wide late turn and finished all out. NIAGARA THUNDER led early, set a reserved pace, vied briefly late backstretch, gained command again on the far turn and moved clear then weakened in the late stages. TAP SHOW, in touch, closed four-wide midway of the far turn, launched a determined drive but evened out late. PRAIRIE FOX was close inside early, stalked on the far turn then showed no response in the stretch. HERE COMES CRISSY was in touch but gave way late turn and had no late response.
