WHAT A PRINCE forced the pace on the backstretch, took a narrow advantage on the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and held sway under a hand ride. MIGHTY MONARCH settled off the early pace, angled out from the rail to four-wide on the turn, angled out more upper stretch and rallied gamely. COWBOY SHEIK stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then finished determinedly in vain. RESULT PLAYER raced midpack along the rail, was hustled between foes late turn and finished all out to no avail. C'MON MAN, steadied slightly just out of the gate, closed quickly, stalked on the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. ATLANTIC KEY raced off the pace, angled from the third path to six-wide under a ride on the turn but never reached contention. SOLVE THE CODE set a pressured pace on the backstretch, forced the issue on the turn then tired in the stretch. RUHTRO raced midpack, angled from the second path to four-wide on the turn, was hustled along but tired in the stretch.
