MIMI COOPER, up close between horses on the backstretch, bid into the turn, dueled then shook clear at the top of the stretch then held, driving. OURANIA raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn and rallied gamely. SKYLAND was up close along the rail but was blocked and eased back a bit at the turn, angled three-wide midturn then rallied outside through the stretch. SPIN MOVE, close up and four-wide into the turn, forced the issue but evened out late. BUSY BELLE, also close early and between rivals, dropped back from tight quarters early turn and faded. EXECUTIVE DECISION broke alertly, closed three-wide into the turn, dueled to the top of the stretch and tired. BRAHMS BEAUTY was hustled to the early lead and the rail, gave way when challenged early turn, chased to the top of the stretch and tired.
