EL RIO BRAVO, close early, chased five-wide and bid late turn, led upper stretch and held sway under a light drive. BEST IN EGBERT, bumped at the start, raced off the pace, chased on the turn then rallied along the rail. MAIL ORDER GROOM forced the pace, dueled on the turn then gave way upper stretch. ANGELIC MIA, bumped at the start, closed on the backstretch and bid into the turn, dueled, was headed upper stretch and gave way. FATHERFORGIVEME, close early, settled off the pace, chased on the turn and finished gamely. EVAC stalked the pace from between rivals, chased four-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. MASTER NOBLE set a pressured early pace, dueled on the turn then tired a furlong out. SPIDER FAN, off slowly, trailed throughout.
