GONETOFARR was in hand well off the rail, closed the gap on the turn and loomed boldly entering the stretch, roused in the drive and assumed command, opened a half length lead and prevailed under steady pressure. GINGER GOLD broke sharply and set the pace in hand outside of TACKY AFFAIR, gave way to the winner in upper stretch, but dug in and battled gamely in the drive. TACKY AFFAIR pressed the early pace from the inside, then weakened in the stretch. MULRAINY was void of early speed, made a mild bid along the rail on the turn, but was never a threat. FAR AND NEAR was void of early speed along the rail and never a factor. MISS NOIRE pressed the early pace three wide, then faltered on the turn and dropped back. DISTANT ROAR reared at the start and lost her jockey.
