AZDECK was hustled from the gate, set the pace then held under a drive. PALACE UPRISING stalked the pace, launched her rally nearing the 1/4 pole and was all out in the stretch. GLADIATORS CONSORT always in range, chased late turn then hung in the stretch. KATHERINE Z well back while saving ground, was blocked midstretch then finished gamely once clear. SETTING THE SCENE broke awkwardly then raced evenly between horses. BORNTOBELOVED was always off the pace, saved ground then lacked a rally. A TWIST OF SHERREE raced midpack three-wide and flattened out in the stretch. PINWINEE WHISKEY chased towards the inside but tired upper stretch.
