Footnotes

CLASSY FLOWER stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn, challenged a furlong out and drove clear with a sixteenth to run. BELIEVE IN MISSY took a short early lead, was headed entering the turn, pressed the pace then rebid inside FRIENDLY THERESA at the top of the stretch, gained command but could not stave off the winner in the final sixteenth. FRIENDLY THERESA moved up outside BELIEVE IN MISSY on the backstretch, took command entering the turn and moved clear briefly, was headed upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. DANA'S LUCKY LADY raced well off the pace while three-wide, finished gamely but failed to threaten. HALIBURTON HONEY was hustled along the rail but failed to menace. CIELO MOON in touch early along the rail, chased on the turn then flattened out. RUCKUS IN COURT broke in the air, was in touch with the leaders on the backstretch, raced three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
