ANOTHER KITTEN set a pressured pace, shook clear into the stretch then was all out to hold at the wire. ROMAN GAMES raced off the pace, closed late turn, launched an all out stretch drive and just missed. FLASHY SURVIVOR stalked the pace, chased late turn and finished gamely. OROCOMO, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, chased hard late turn then rallied along the rail. NAMATH chased hard from midpack then evened out in the late stages. ARGUMENT CLOSE settled well off the pace, closed late turn and rallied belatedly. GRAND REQUEST, rated in midpack, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the final 16th. AUTOMATIC PROSPECT raced in midpack along the rail, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. DAZZLE ME DANNY raced off the pace, saved ground but never reached contention. SHACKLETON HILL forced the pace, chased into the stretch and tired. BROMPTON ROAD, in range, chased between foes on the turn then evened out in the stretch. PERSONAL SIGNAL, in range, was hustled four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. NO YOUR BOUNDARIES bumped with a rival at the start, forced the pace, chased to the top of the stretch and tired. MAKAR stalked the pace then faded through the turn.
