MACHO WHISKEY, in range, closed four-wide late turn, responded smartly and swept to the lead in deep stretch, driving. BRANDYMAN moved up to duel three-wide late backstretch, shook clear late turn, had command in the stretch but failed to contain the winner in the late stages. AIR BLADE, rated midpack between foes, chased three-wide into the stretch then finished gamely along the rail. HEBERT HALL, rated in midpack, closed late backstretch, stalked on the turn then evened out. TERRAQUANT broke alertly but inward, settled midpack between rivals, was hustled on the turn then evened out. DISCREET KID raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. ALGONQUIN led early, was joined late backstretch, dueled, was headed midturn, chased to the stretch and tired. TWILIGHT SHADOW settled off the pace, chased three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. WOODY G dueled from late backstretch, was headed midturn, chased to the stretch and tired.
