Footnotes

ESSENCE HIT MAN showed early speed alongside SIGNATURE RED, edged clear on the main track, set a reserved pace then held sway under steady encouragement. BIG BAND SOUND raced off the pace, closed two-wide late turn, chased into the stretch and was all out to the wire. PASO DOBLE stalked the pace in hand on the backstretch, was hustled four-wide late turn but evened out in deep stretch. SIGNATURE RED forced the pace in the early going, chased two and three-wide on the turn then finished gamely to no avail. BEAR TOUGH TIGER stalked the pace, chased hard late turn then evened out in the stretch. NO HESITATION, rated off the early pace, was hustled through the turn while being outrun and was eased in the late stages.
