**Footnotes**

GUITAR SOLO stalked the pace, closed four-wide late turn, swept by the duelers upper stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. TOP PROSPECT settled off the pace, closed angling out late turn, chased five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. CONSOLIDATOR JOE had brief speed then forced the issue, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. CARBON FOOTPRINT held a short lead late backstretch, set a pressured pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled briefly, was passed, then chased to the end. RED STRIKE had early speed, stalked on the turn, was roused in the stretch and responded gamely in vain. THE BOY'S RING, under strong early restraint, stalked the pace, bid along the rail at the top of the stretch, vied briefly and evened out. FAST TIME broke outward, was under strong rating near the rear of the tightly-knit pack, was squeezed back from between foes at the turn, chased along the rail and tired in the stretch.
