Footnotes

WHATA GEM stalked the pace from the rail, remained patient while lacing a path late turn, drove to the lead a furlong out and was clear then held NO CHEATING safe. NO CHEATING stalked the pace, bid three-wide at the top of the stretch then finished determinedly. MON AMI AMY remained well off the pace until straightened away for the stretch run then rallied between horses. ANGEL IN TIGHTS was well off the early pace, came four-deep into the stretch and rallied willingly, but late. SWEET WILL'S JOY forced the pace to the turn then dueled to the stretch and tired. BOLDSEA was unhurried early, saved ground then finished evenly. SULTRY FLUFF stalked the pace from between horses, was in striking range at the top of the stretch but flattened out. REDCARPETTREATMENT was sent hard to the front and had command down the backstretch, dueled on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. ROZYS ACCOUNT trailed and lacked a closing response.
