Footnotes

D'S LEGEND STORM was prominent at the outset but settled, was hustled from midpack on the turn, rallied smartly and got by late under a drive. DOCTOR JACK forced the pace, bid just into final furlong, bested the early pacesetter a sixteenth out but was outfinished. PANTASTIC raced off the pace, was roused late turn then rallied gamely, but late. IT'S TIME BEAR stalked close up, launched his bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, was determined, but hung. IWILLGOTOTHEMOON led early, set a pressured pace, drove clear at the top of the stretch then gave way grudgingly in the final sixteenth. AREPEATEE, close early, settled, was hustled four-wide late turn then rallied mildly and did not threaten. OFFICEINTHEVALLEY, in range, chased from midturn then flattened out midstretch. ABRUPTLY raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide into the stretch but never reached contention.
