Footnotes

CAN IHAVETHISDANCE raced prominently from the start, allowed first TENET and then EXCEPTIONALLY to take command then sprinted clear when asked at the head of the stretch and widened under a hand ride. SILKY TRESSES stalked four-wide on the first turn and remained close on the third path, then finished all out in the stretch. EXCEPTIONALLY stalked from the rail, took command on the backstretch, set a pressured pace to the top of the stretch then was no match for the winner when that one wanted the lead back. WILD VANILLA raced midpack then closed three-wide leaving the turn. EMPRESS OF SHEBA trailed early, closed along the rail leaving the backstretch then hung in the stretch. LIVE WELL far back early, closed along the rail into the far turn, angled three-wide on the turn and continued on without threatening. MINNIE'S MEADOW raced midpack on the first and second paths while maintaining striking distance, advanced on the far turn but tired in the stretch. UNBRIDLED ROSE was well back from the outset, raced four-wide, came six-wide into the stretch and flattened out. ROYAL ATTRACTION stalked the pace to the far turn and tired. TENET showed speed briefly, set a pressured pace to the backstretch and gave way.
