Footnotes

BEFORE MIDNIGHT bid three-wide into the turn, dueled, then moved clear at the 1/4 pole and was kept to business through the stretch. OSGOODE HALL closed three-deep on the turn and finished willingly to no avail. G T' S HELENOFROY bid between foes entering the turn, dueled to the 1/4 pole and could no longer match strides with BEFORE MIDNIGHT, chased that one into the stretch then tired. KEFFA led quickly, was joined at the turn and dueled to the 1/4 pole and gave way then tired in the stretch. ROYAL BABE well back early, saved ground but did not threaten. BLUE WARBLER well back early, was under hard urging through the turn while on the fourth path then lacked a stretch response. FLASHIN LADY was hustled four-wide through the turn then finished evenly and did not threaten. BELLA MOSELLA raced midpack on the second path, was roused on the turn but showed no response.
