Footnotes

MOBILIZER was well back early, closed nearing the far turn, bid three-wide late turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed under a drive. SMART SKY, unhurried for the first half-mile, closed late backstretch, circled on the turn, bid five-wide at the top of the stretch, vied to the end and just missed. PRIZED HUMOUR raced off the pace, closed between foes late turn then rallied determinedly. VICAR STREET, well back early, closed between horses late turn then finished gamely in vain. TREND, well back early, chased up close on the far turn, failed to match strides with a rail bid late turn and tired. CAPTAIN CANUCK, well back early, angled from four to nine-wide on the final turn then evened out in the stretch. INDY LEAGUE saved ground and raced off the pace, was hustled through the far turn then evened out in the stretch. COGNASHENE, well back early, was hustled between foes late turn but lacked a strong late response. WHATATA TOUGH KNIGHT broke in the air, closed on the backstretch, chased late turn then lacked a rally. GOLD STRIKE BEGINS closed on the backstretch, took command midturn, was headed late turn and tired in the stretch. OVERSHADOW, always well back, lacked a rally. RAVEN

STONE closed on the far turn angling from four to seven-wide but tired approaching the stretch. MR FULLER led quickly, drew off a long lead, was caught at the far turn and tired midturn. SOUL SEEKER raced off the pace, faded between foes late backstretch and trailed home.
