MISS GRINDSTONE was always in touch between horses, moved to the rail in the stretch, rallied willingly and got up late. DRESSED FOR ACTION dueled inside FLASHY SILVER, edged clear on the turn, had command to deep stretch then failed to hold the winner safe. RUCKUS IN COURT stalked, closed three-wide out of the turn and was all out in the stretch. TEEWEE'S HOPE trailed along the second path, angled out for the stretch drive and finished full of run. FLASHY SILVER dueled to the turn then chased hard after the leader, was still contentious but tired a furlong out. TEMPERANCE LAKE moved off the rail midturn, closed gradually three-wide then flattened out in the stretch. DANCE LESSONS saved ground and was never in contention. MOONLITE WALK stalked the pace from the rail then tired in the final furlong. DANA'S LUCKY LADY raced midpack then faded four-wide on the turn.
