SOUL BLUES raced off the pace, swung seven-wide closing late turn, rallied gamely and swept by late under a hand ride. PAYTON'S VICTORY set a pressured early pace, was clear on the turn, turned back a rival at the top of the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe in the late stages. EXCHANGE BANDIT forced the pace, chased two-wide on the turn then evened out late. BOLD STATEMENT, up close in hand, was hustled along the rail late turn, failed with a bid at the top of the stretch then chased to the end. BUSH BANDIT raced midpack, closed into the turn, was hustled along, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then finished gamely to no avail. GALLIPOLI stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn then evened out. WILD MANDATE, rated off the pace, saved ground, closed late turn but did not threaten. NAVY BAND, close early, settled, chased late turn then flattened out in the stretch. DESTINED TO SHINE stalked on the backstretch, raced five-wide on the turn, faded late turn then lacked a rally.
