Footnotes

NUMEROUS EXECUTIVE, in range, closed from late backstretch, challenged late turn, dueled into the stretch, moved clear a furlong out and held sway under a hand ride. TOKYO BAY led early, set a pressured pace, was collared late turn, dueled into the stretch but yielded a furlong out then chased to the end. WISDOM ADMIRAL raced off the early pace, chased hard late turn, came five-wide into the stretch and finished all out. SINKER stalked the pace to the backstretch then moved up to force the issue, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. LAST CENTURY raced midpack, was hustled along the rail on the far turn but never threatened. KINNAIRD raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn angling from three to seven-wide but never reached contention. GOLD XCHANGE stalked the pace, chased hard from early on the far turn then tired a sixteenth out. STALACTITE, rated off the pace, saved ground, was hustled on the far turn but lacked a closing response.
