HOLLYWOOD HIT led early under pressure, moved clear on the main track, set the pace, kicked away upper stretch and held sway under a drive. FATAL BULLET forced the pacesetter early, settled and stalked the pace keeping the leader in his sights, chased into the stretch and finished all out. SIGNATURE RED settled and stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then finished gamely to no avail. FIELD COMMISSION raced off the pace, quickened late backstretch, angled from the second path to four-wide under a ride on the turn, chased in striking rage into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. GRAZETTES LANDING raced in the middle of the pack, was hustled along while saving ground, launched an all out drive in the stretch but evened out. TOGETHER INDY raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. AWESOME RHYTHM raced off the pace, was hustled from well back on the turn but never reached contention.
