### Footnotes

TH ORIGINAL SCOTTY raced off the pace, angled out closing late turn then rallied smartly moving in to the rail through the stretch and was up in the late stages, driving. MIA'S ROCKET stalked the pace, closed up and forced the issue late turn, took a short lead in the final furlong but was caught late. PARK PLACE pressed the pace, bid into the turn, set a pressured pace, was headed in the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. FORESTERS PRIDE, away alertly, stalked the pace, was hustled late turn but evened out in deep stretch. POUR ONE MORE pressed the pace, bid into the turn, was headed quickly, chased, but evened out in midstretch. RIVER CARD raced in midpack, closed late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then evened out. R PAYNES PRINCE, off slowly, stalked in the early going, dropped back to midpack early turn then lacked a rally. RESAMA, well back early, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. ASAFABOLT led onto the main track, was joined near the turn, gave way, chased but tired in the stretch. MY PARISIO raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn then tired in the stretch. WISDOM RIVER pressed the pace, bid late backstretch, dueled, was headed early turn then tired in the stretch.
