DANIEL BE GOOD led early, set a reserved pace then held sway under a strong hand ride. DELAFORCE raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn, finished gamely and was up late for the place. GRAPES pressed the early pace, chased hard on the turn then finished determinedly. VEGAS WEEKEND dropped well off the pace, saved ground, closed into the stretch and rallied along the rail. JET SET EXEC pressed the pace, chased on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. RING OF GREATNESS raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn then came with a late run between foes. BUY WITH GOLD raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch but did not threaten. CHARLIE BULL raced in midpack, was hustled two-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but failed to menace. PADRAIG settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. FAYE'S GRAY, steadied just out, raced off the pace, chased hard angling from three to five-wide on the turn then tired midstretch.
