### Footnotes

ITZHOWEROLL, off slowly, raced in midpack, came out and bumped a rival at the turn, angled out further and chased from midturn, bid in the final furlong, dueled and prevailed late under a drive. BEAR NO JOKE stalked the pace, bid into the turn, dueled, shook clear upper stretch, was joined in the final furlong, dueled but was outfinished. ESCAPISM, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, chased late turn and finished all out. CANDY BULL, bumped at the start, stalked the pace, chased along the rail through the turn then evened out in deep stretch. BIG BAD BUTCH, bid into the turn, dueled, but gave way at the top of the stretch. CALL FOR SILVER raced in midpack, chased six-wide into the stretch then failed to menace. JOLSON had speed, dueled on the turn, was headed upper stretch and flattened out. DO THE MATH raced in midpack, was bumped and checked hard at the turn, was hustled along but was not a threat. SOLO PLAYER, off slowly, raced in midpack, was hustled into the stretch then had no late response. AINTNOFLYSONME, rated off the pace, closed quickly into the turn, chased four to six-wide then tired in the stretch.
